### **Continued dedication to the environment: No to Crown Hydro!**

One example of my dedication to our riverfront and environment is my opposition to Crown Hydro, a proposed hydropower generation station to be built on the Mississippi River in downtown Minneapolis.

The project has gone through several revisions in its quest for city approval. It currently would be constructed on the west side of the Mississippi River, near the foot of the Stone Arch Bridge. The plant potentially threatens St. Anthony Falls and the Mississippi River itself by diverting water away from the site.

In the coming year, decisions will be made that determine the fate of this very destructive project. I am the only candidate running for the 3rd Ward City Council seat that has consistently stood against this project. In fact, a fundraiser hosted by one of my opponents three weeks ago was co-sponsored by a Crown Hydro representative.

As the debate around this project move forward, know that I will continue to fight against development that stands to devastate our natural resources. Our city and our ward's futures

are at stake in this election. Make me your #1 choice, and continue the vision for a thriving 3rd Ward!
